### Write a story

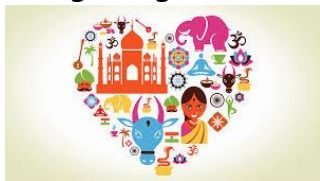
Write an adventure story about a place you have visited. Maybe a holiday or day trip.
