<p>English Our Power of Reading text this term is The Hodgeheg by Dick King-Smith. We will be exploring the text by writing descriptive passages, information texts and an author profile. We will also have a chance to compose our own stories titled Max Crosses the Road! We will continue to work through the Year 2 objectives for Reading and Writing. Daily 5 will continue every day. During this time, one group of children will be reading with the teacher, one group will be listening to reading, one group will be reading independently, one group will be working on writing and the other group will be working on spelling.</p>	<p>Maths This term we will be concentrating on consolidating the children's knowledge and understanding, and teaching exam techniques in preparation of the SATs. Snappy Maths will continue to be used daily where will recall mental facts relating to addition and multiplication. We will continue to use Beat That to test our mental recall skills. CLIC tests will be sent home on Mondays and then completed again in class on Fridays.</p>	
<p>Science We will be looking at habitats and our dependency on them. We will also be investigating nocturnal animals.</p>	<p>Phonics and Spelling Phonics underpins all of our reading and writing. We will continue to have a daily spelling lesson. Spellings will be sent home on Mondays and tested on Fridays.</p>	<p>Geography We will be mapping the school, adding on light sources and exploring sunrise and sunset on clocks. We will be studying Iceland, exploring their long days of darkness.</p>
<p>Art We will be using clay to sculpt, focusing on form. We will link this to our text and our investigation into nocturnal animals by sculpting hedgehogs.</p>	<p>Computing In computing this term, we will be continue to use the iPads and Chromebooks, concentrating on using the keyboard to input text.</p>	<p>PSHE We will continue to have Sunshine Friend this term and practise complimenting each other. We will have regular circle times to discuss any issues that arise in the class.</p>
<p>PE During PE, we will be practicing the skills we will need for sports day, including athletics, throwing and jumping.</p>	<p>RE This term, we will be reading the stories of the Prodigal son and the Great Feast.</p> <p>Forest School We will start this term by filming the telling of the own narratives set within the woods that we wrote last term. Over a number of sessions, we will explore den building, allowing the children to build and improve on their ideas.</p>
