Family Questionnaires – March 2017

Thank you so much for taking time to respond to our Tree Tops Family Questionnaire at the end of term. We had 103 responses an increase of 86 on 2016.

What this tells us:

The results were **really positive** and we have made the table below for you to see the breakdown of responses.

We can see that there are specific areas that you would like us to give you more information, which are:

- Communication about your child's needs and keeping you informed of additional support in place to help them learn.
- Communication about the Academy policy and procedure around bullying and actions to tackle any incidents effectively.
- Ensuring homework is engaging and matches your child's learning needs.

What we are going to do now:

- This term a letter will come home to all parents and carers outlining all the learning strategies your teacher and teaching assistant use to support learning with them.
- If your child has additional and different interventions these will continue to be outlined in a letter and you will be invited to meet with Mrs Bryant or Mrs Wickham to discuss these, following on from the recent parent consultation meetings.
- Give anti-bullying a very high profile across the school, through assemblies, in lessons and during free times of the day.
- We have already reviewed assemblies to ensure clear and key messages about the Academy ethos and values and zero-tolerance of bullying behaviour can be delivered and discussed by Mrs Guthrie and Mrs Roberts in key stages.
- Older pupils called 'Peer Mediators' will help lead assemblies and offer support to work out differences.
- Review our lunchtime arrangements and staffing for this time of day.
- Increase the opportunities for you to talk to senior staff, informally at the end of the day.
- Ask you to ensure as adults we use appropriate language on the school grounds at all times.



- Send out our Behaviour Policy and Pupil Behaviour Policy to all parents in Term 5.
- Review Homework arrangements in Term 5.
