English Our term is based on the book "The Time-Travelling Cat and the Egyptian Goddess" by Julia Jarman. This book has a lot of features within it that provide great opportunities for writing in different ways and different learning. As the book is partially set within Egypt, it links into our Topic nicely to support our learning further. From this book, we are going to be looking closely at the use of descriptive phrases and adjectives, while we will also be learning about when and how to use adverbials and prepositions to support our writing. Grammar, punctuation and spelling will all be continued to be a focus also.		Maths For maths this term, our main focus is on place value. We will be learning about this in a variety of ways, starting with Roman Numerals! In addition to this, we are going to be learning about our place values up to 10,000. During this, we are going to be using the skills we develop in a variety of different mathematical forms, such as working out 1000 more/less than a number; while moving onto adding together two four-digit numbers. To support our understanding further, we are going to be using word problems, as we must then work out what the question is really asking! We are also going to be looking at our times tables up to 12 each week.	
Science This term we will be focusing on all living things and the environment. We will be learning about how we can classify animals across the world and investigating various environments from all over the world. We are also looking at how we can help to save the environment.	Music Music this term will be taught by Miss Cuthbertson on a Wednesday. We will be looking at the history of music and the music of Ancient Egypt.		Art For Art this term we will be focusing on sketching. We will be sketching both items found in real-life and models from Ancient Egypt, using a variety of equipment to alter our sketches.
Geography/History For History and Geography this term, our focus is on Ancient Egypt. We will be locating Egypt on the world map and discussing this. We are going to investigate many factors of Ancient Egypt, including the Gods and comparing this to everyday life.	Computing This term will be focused on E-safety. Children will be learning many important facts about how to stay safe and sensible online at all times.		Reading Our main focus for this terms reading is developing our comprehension skills. We will be doing guided reading weekly to further our reading skills also.
