<p>Task 1</p>	<p>Draw a picture or make a model of your favourite woodland animal. You can use whatever you like e.g. junk modelling (cardboard boxes, yoghurt pots, toilet rolls etc.), Lego or clay/playdough, bring it into class for us to display.</p>		
<p>Task 2</p>	<p>Choose your favourite woodland animal to research information about. You could draw and label your animal and its habitat or write some interesting facts about an animal and its habitat.</p>		
<p>Task 3</p>	<p>Read a Percy the Park Keeper story Draw pictures to show the different events in the story, Write about your favourite parts or maybe you could write your own short story about the characters.</p>		
<p>Task 4</p> <p>AUTUMN Scavenger Hunt</p>	<p>Go on an Autumn scavenger hunt, write or draw what you spot and how many of each thing there are, e.g. 2 squirrels playing in a tree, 15 conkers laying on the ground.</p>
