- To extend our sentences to include words like 'and'.
- Read my writing back to an adult.

Number and Shape Skills

- To identify 2D shape and 3D shapes
- To talk about the properties of 2D and 3D shapes.
- To identify and order numbers to 20.
- To join two sets of objects.
- To take an amount away from a set of objects.
- To double or halve a given number.

Theme Builder

- Plant a seed or bulb.
- Go on a mini beast hunt.
- Design a garden.
