

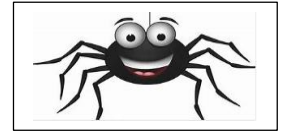

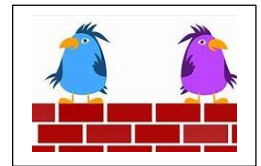
The way we share our ideas and values can influence others.

Reading and Writing Skills

- Express likes and dislikes about stories and nursery rhymes.
- Use paint, pencils and crayons to represent characters from nursery rhymes.
- Recognise our names.
- Strengthen our fingers and develop control by threading small objects.

Number and Shape Skills

- Develop counting skills through number rhymes and songs.
- Begin to say number names in order.
- Recognise and name basic shapes – circle, square, triangle and rectangle
- Explore 3D shapes by building and model making.

Theme Builder

- Learn and perform a variety of nursery rhymes.
- Make musical instruments.
- Represent nursery rhymes in art in both 2D and 3D.
- Make connections between songs and celebrations in our lives – birthdays and Christmas.

Other Skills

- Learn the names of our new friends.
- Have a go at new activities.
- Remember the routines of our class.
- Use words to express ourselves.
- Put on and take off our coats independently.
