Number and Shape Skills

- Develop counting skills through number rhymes and songs.
- Say number names in order.
- Look for patterns around us and experiment making our own.
- Introduce the language of measurement – longer, shorter, heavier, lighter

Theme Builder

- Identify different vehicles.
- Sort different types of transport
- Use descriptive language to describe what we can see.
- Investigate floating and sinking
- Investigate the texture and pattern when looking at tyres.

Other Skills

- Learn the names of our new friends as they join our class.
- Develop independence when making learning choices.
- Remember the routines of our class.
- Experiment with colour mixing.
