Dear Parents

Please just call us at school or message/email us and we will be happy to help you. They can also exchange messages with their teachers and communicate with other children in their class. I saw in one Google classroom today that one boy was receiving birthday wishes which was lovely. It's a bit like a 'learning Facebook page' and much easier to use than you might think!
